What's going on?

Thanks to the national focus groups and the thorough survey carried out by partners, the consortium has developed a detailed programme with all the relevant topics that should be covered. We have been asking end users about their level of knowledge on different processes and stages of the olive oil cultivation and production, types of fertilization they know, materials used in the processes such as mulching or irrigation.

The partners are now working on the content for a series of educational videos on the stages and processes of the olive oil production chain, dealing with topics such as planting, fertilizing or mulching.

What's next?

And what's more, partners will be meeting once again in person in March 2026 for a transnational meeting, once **the Go2Grove Digital Handbook** is published and ready to be distributed, in order to analyse its impact and plan next steps.
